ALL ITEMS MUST BE NAMED

Hair styles. All hair must be kept off the face and tied back if below the collar. Only small black or dark green hair accessories/head bands can be used. Shaved heads should not be less than a number 2 and hair must be of natural colour.

Jewellery. Only stud earrings can be worn. No other jewellery unless for religious reasons. Watches can be worn but we strongly recommend no expensive watches. Please be aware that it is unsafe to wear any jewellery for sport so it will need to be removed for some activities.

Mobile phones are not permitted in school. If your child requires a phone for before or after school, please let us know and it must be handed into the office at the start of the day and collected at the end.

Pencil cases and equipment. All stationery equipment is provided in school but children may bring in their own. Pencil cases must be small enough to fit into their tray under their desk.
